The WKP Kennedy Gallery is a gathering place for art and art ideas. We offer a forum for artistic dialogue and development to the people of North Bay and Northeastern Ontario.

The WKP Kennedy Gallery is now accepting submissions for the upcoming exhibition: **2020 Hindsight**. Hindsight is a word that implies reflection and 20/20 is used to describe perfect vision. When we reflect on past situations and experiences, we begin to see things more clearly and from a new perspective. Now that we are over halfway through this year lets look back and reflect; hindsight may be 20/20, but we need hindsight for 2020.

This exhibition is to promote community engagement and we are welcoming submissions and participation from everyone. Participants should feel inspired to respond to/ interpret this exhibition in anyway that is meaningful to them. Whatever it may be, we hope that engagement in this exhibition will offer the community 20/20 vision in their reflection.

Artists can submit up to 3 projects in any media including painting, drawing, prints, photography, video, sculpture, textile, writing, poetry, etc. Artists can submit works with dimensions up to 20×20 inches (2D) and $20 \times 20 \times 20$ (3D). Video submissions can be up to 5 minutes in length and digital images must be 300dpi. Submissions will be accepted by mail in, drop off, or email. Emailed submissions will be projected onto the gallery walls or presented on a screen in the gallery. All submissions must include a completed submission form. Please refer to the submission guidelines to ensure that you submit your work properly.

Process:

- 1. Create **up to 3** artworks in response to the exhibition theme. Previous work which reflects the theme will be accepted but must have been made in 2020.
- 2. Fill Submission Form
- 3. Artists can submit works with dimensions up to 20×20 inches (2D) and $20 \times 20 \times 20$ (3D). Video submissions can be up to 5 minutes in length and digital images must be 300dpi. Submissions will be accepted by mail in, drop off, or email.
- 4. Submit artwork according to delivery options

- d) Put in the subject of email your Name, Hindsight 2020 i.e. "Joe Bloggs, Hindsight 2020"

- 5. All artwork must be clearly identified on the artwork. Write your name and artwork title on the back or bottom of your piece.
- 6. All 2D and 3D artwork must be ready to hang or stand on a pilaster
- 7. Artwork will not be for sale
- 8. Accepting submissions as of September 1st until September 28th
- 9. All received artwork will be on display from October 8th to December 19th, 2020
- 10. Exhibition will be available to the public by booking a viewing appointment. Email <u>alix@kennedygallery.org</u> to book a viewing.
- 11. Artwork will be returned and picked up in January of 2021 after the gallery winter closure.
